Job Summary

The Quality Inspector Team Leader performs CMM programming, quality audits, inspections, tests, and measurement duties on standard products and processes to ensure conformance to product requirements. Coaching and work direction for personnel in aspects of product quality and inspection. Quality Inspector Team Leader may recommend process or improvement changes with various departments including Manufacturing, Engineering, and Supply Chain.

Essential Functions

- Foster/sustain "Voice of Quality" and "Quality 1st mindset".
- Performs visual and mechanical inspection of product and components per documented procedures; specification; drawings; or accepted manufacturing practices, using measuring equipment (i.e., caliper, micrometer, tape measures, color standards).
- Responsible for controlling, monitoring, and quarantining of non-conformant product and materials.
- Understands the requirements of the Quality System such as: best documentation. practices, quality standards, and basic ISO requirements.
- Responsible for NCMR Submissions.
- Responsible for Receiving Record Document Management.
- Update and maintain Inspection Procedure Submissions/DCR's.
- Accept/release received materials.
- Report to leadership monthly on Inspection Department stats and metrics.
- Establish staffing needs of Department.
- Responsible for CMM Programming and Operations.
- Provides training to all new inspectors and Line leads pertaining to quality processes.
- Acts as backup to all quality functions including receiving inspection, and quality engineering.
- Support company finance, accounting, human resources, quality, regulatory, and clinical departments as necessary to ensure compliance with requirements.
